The mission of the Northfield Township Food Pantry is to provide assistance to Township residents who are having trouble providing food for themselves and their families.

Dear Friends,

Thanks to the generous donations of food, financial assistance and volunteer hours, the Northfield Township Food Pantry is helping a growing number of local low-income families. Our client base continues to increase in these times of economic hardship. However, with your help, we're assisting 1,450 Township residents every month.

During the March 2010-February 2011 fiscal year, the Pantry:

- **Provided food and grocery cards to an average of 497 local families each month (an average of 1,450 individuals).**
- **Distributed over \$166,000 in grocery gift cards.**
- **Continued to expand the produce distribution program, supplying fresh fruits and vegetables to clients every week.**
- **Held month-long holiday programs in November, December and April, distributing extra food and grocery cards to clients.**
- **Gave out 370 sets of school supplies to elementary and high school students.**
- **Distributed Easter/Spring baskets and birthday gifts to clients' children.**
- **Hosted a Halloween "Trunk and Treat" event for clients' children.**
- **Participated in community fundraising events, including "Heart of Glenview" and the annual Northfield Farmers' Market corn roast.**
