

Glenview Northbrook Community Collaboration:
March 6 Update on Coronavirus (COVID-19)

As leaders in Glenview and Northbrook, together, we are strongly committed to protecting the health and well-being of all our communities. We formed the Glenview-Northbrook Coronavirus Task Force, made up of representatives from the municipalities, schools, township, park districts and libraries in our communities. Earlier this week, members met in both Glenview and Northbrook, and will come together regularly to share information and resources about the novel coronavirus, and the illness that it causes, COVID-19. The entities plan to take consistent and coordinated action whenever possible.

We also are committed to providing accurate, timely and valuable information. To that end, expect to receive a joint weekly message each Friday for as long as there is concern about the novel coronavirus. A newly created web page (<http://www.glenviewnorthbrookcoronavirus.info>) will provide vetted information to help Glenview and Northbrook community members understand the facts and get answers to frequently asked questions. We will continue to update the page as necessary with more specific guidance in the event of confirmed cases in Northfield Township, and any protocols that our organizations and our communities as a whole will follow as a result.

We ask that you keep the lines of communication open as well. Please reach out to your health care provider if you believe you have been exposed to the virus.

We follow the guidance of the Cook County Department of Health, Illinois Department of Public Health, and the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention about the novel coronavirus. These sources confirm that ***as of this writing, there are no cases in our communities, and the risk of contracting the virus remains low.***

Here are a few details we would like to highlight at this time:

- [The CDC's Travel Health Notices page](#) as of today recommends a 14-day quarantine for individuals returning from China, Italy, Iran, and South Korea.
- We encourage you to practice healthy habits to reduce the spread of germs, including:
 - Stay home if you are sick, and keep sick children home from school and other activities until they are fever-free for 24 hours without the use of fever-reducing drugs.
 - Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds, especially after going to the bathroom; before eating; and after blowing your nose, coughing, or sneezing.
 - If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that has at least 60% alcohol content and is not expired.
 - Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
 - Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
 - Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
 - Clean and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces.
 - Do not share eating utensils or drinking containers.

Monitoring the situation and responding to any changes will continue to be a strong, coordinated effort across Glenview and Northbrook.

Community leaders from Glenview and Northbrook meet Wednesday, March 4, to share resources and information about the novel coronavirus (COVID-19).

Como líderes en Glenview y Northbrook, juntos, estamos firmemente comprometidos en proteger la salud y el bienestar de todos los miembros de nuestra comunidad. Por tal motivo, hemos formado un grupo de trabajo para abordar el tema del Coronavirus en Glenview-Northbrook, este grupo es compuesto por representantes de los municipios, escuelas, villas, distritos de parques y bibliotecas de nuestras comunidades. A principios de esta semana, los miembros de este equipo se reunieron tanto en Glenview como en Northbrook, y continuarán reuniéndose regularmente para compartir información y recursos sobre el nuevo coronavirus y las enfermedades que causan el COVID-19. Dichas entidades y organizaciones planean tomar medidas consistentes y coordinadas siempre que sea posible.

También estamos comprometidos en proporcionar información precisa, oportuna y valiosa. Con ese fin, espere recibir un mensaje semanal todos los viernes durante el tiempo que este nuevo virus sea relevante y de preocupación. La siguiente página web (<http://www.glenviewnorthbrookcoronavirus.info>) proveerá información oficial para los miembros de nuestras comunidades en Glenview y Northbrook. El sitio web le asistirá para comprender datos claves y para obtener respuestas a preguntas frecuentes. Además, el sitio web se mantendrá actualizándose con una guía a seguir y con información específica en el caso de que se detecten casos en las municipalidades en Northfield, también se incluirá cualquier protocolo que nuestras organizaciones y comunidades deberán seguir unificadamente como resultado de dichos casos.

Por favor, mantenga las líneas de comunicación abiertas con nosotros y póngase en contacto con su médico si usted sospecha que ha sido expuesto al coronavirus.

Con respecto al nuevo coronavirus, el distrito sigue la guianza del Departamento de Salud del Condado de Cook, del Departamento de Salud Pública de Illinois, y del Centro de Control y Prevención de enfermedades. Los departamentos previamente mencionados confirman que, hasta el momento de **escribir este mensaje, no hay casos reportados en nuestra comunidad, y el riesgo de contraer el virus permanece bajo.**

A continuación algunos factores importantes a considerar:

- [El sitio de internet CDC con información de salud para viajeros](#), al día de hoy recomienda que todos los individuos que regresan de China, Italia, Irán y Corea del sur, se sujeten a 14 días en cuarentena.
- Para reducir el esparcimiento de gérmenes, le alentamos a practicar hábitos de prevención, como los siguientes:
 - Quédese en casa si está enfermo y mantenga a los niños enfermos en casa fuera de la escuela y otras actividades hasta que estén sin fiebre durante 24 horas y sin la necesidad de que tomen medicamentos para reducir la fiebre.
 - Lávese las manos a menudo con agua y jabón durante al menos 20 segundos, especialmente después de ir al baño; antes de comer; y después de sonarse la nariz, toser o estornudar.
 - Si no hay agua y jabón disponibles, use un desinfectante para manos a base de alcohol que tenga al menos un 60% de contenido de alcohol y que no haya caducado.
 - Evite tocarse los ojos, la nariz y la boca con las manos sin lavar.
 - Evitar el contacto cercano con personas que están enfermas.
 - Cubra su tos o estornude con un pañuelo desechable, luego tírelo a la basura.
 - Limpie y desinfecte objetos y superficies que se tocan con frecuencia..
 - No comparta utensilios para comer ni recipientes para beber..

Monitorear la situación y responder a cualquier cambio continuará siendo un esfuerzo fuerte y coordinado en Glenview y Northbrook.
